Due in part to the cold and wet winter, some of our horses are exhibiting cold like symptoms. One pony, Abba Zabba, has tested positive for EHV-4. **DO NOT feed, pet, touch Abba.**

EHV-4 is an upper respiratory virus, restricted to the infection of the respiratory tract epithelium and its associated lymph nodes. "EHV-4 is a respiratory form that does not cause neurological disease but can result in secondary pneumonia"-per our vet. In some cases, EHV-4 can progress into pneumonia.

We have 2 horses, **Cooper and Graffiti**, that are currently on antibiotics to treat pneumonia. They have tested negative for EHV-4 but are still contagious. **Avoid any contact with these horses.**

All horses that are showing any symptoms (snotty nose, cough) are being stall rested, tested, and treated along by Conejo Valley Equine. These include **Blueberry, Forrest, Bert** currently. We will update this list daily. **Again, avoid contact these horses.**

By recommendation from our vet, we are voluntarily quarantining all horses for 2 weeks. Therefore, no horses will be entering the barn or leaving the barn until we have been given clearance from Conejo Valley Equine.

This virus is spread by nasal discharge and cough, so please help us by keeping all the horses healthy by:

- Washing hands between horses.
- Avoid touching horses with symptoms.
- Avoid horse to horse contact (school horses showing symptoms are being isolated).

Please contact Foxfield staff (Shelly, Janie, Katie, Chloe, Nadia) if you see any horses with symptoms. Thank you for helping us keep Foxfield safe!
